




Percentage of U.S. Households That Own an Outdoor Grill or Smoker

- ■80% of US homeowners own a grill or smoker
- This is a significant increase from 2019 when only 64% of US homeowners owned a grill or smoker
- ■63% of grill owners grill year round
- Believe it or not, 43% of grill owners cook at least once a month in the winter
- This represents a popular trend to making grilling a regular activity rather than an occasional event.






Outdoor Living – What to Expect in the Future

- The demand for outdoor living space has grown by 50% since 2020.
- Key trends experienced are expected to continue into the future includes:
 - Creating multifunctional spaces that can accommodate relaxation, entertainment and even remote work!
 - Creating outdoor spaces that reflect the homeowners unique personality
 - The inclusion of smart technology. Expect to see anything from motorized louvres, integrated LED lighting or voice-activated controls

- The National Association of Realtors notes that **64% of**homeowners desire to create a multi-functional outdoor area.
- ■75% of millennials have shown interest in creating outdoor kitchens.
- ■There has been a **40% increase** in the desire for outdoor space with customization being a priority.

Patio Design for the Future

It is anticipated that the outdoor living market will be a \$26.8 billion industry by 2027. Expect to see these elements included in future designs.

- The inclusion of natural elements like plants, water features and natural materials
- The use of eco-friendly materials like aluminum and responsibly sourced wood
- Making sure the outdoor space provides flexibility and adaptability to suit a homeowner's changing needs
- Items like retractable screens or privacy walls to create an intimate space

Outdoor Room

- Increase in popularity since 2020
- Promoted in home, design & landscape magazines & home improvement shows
- An outdoor room may be a kitchen, an entertaining area, an area with a fireplace, may contain a fire pit, & have other features
- It is an extension of the indoor living area to the outdoors
- May include a Deck / patio / gazebo / pergola / pavilion / open area / under an umbrella / covered or uncovered / with or without a roof structure / the list is endless

Basic Elements of an Outdoor Room

- Place to gather (seating, furniture)
- ■Place to eat and/or drink (table)
- Shelter for rain or shade from sun
- Heat to provide warmth on a cool night
 - Patio Heater, Fireplace, Fire Pit
- Cooking Area (Grill)
- Ambiance (Tiki Torches, Gas Lights)
- Serenity (maybe a water feature)

Cooking Outdoors

- No outdoor room is complete without a natural gas grill or kitchen
- Natural gas grills are fast, convenient, safe and easy to use
- Outdoor cooking also keeps the indoor kitchen cooler, reducing home-cooling costs in the summer
- A natural gas grill can be installed on a permanent post, attached to a cart with a quick disconnect that enables the grill to be moved when not in use, or built into a decorative brick or other type of enclosure

Natural Gas Grills

- Never run out of propane while cooking a meal or have to move heavy tanks
- Less expensive to operate than propane grills
- Eliminate the clean-up with charcoal grills

Trends in Grills

- Infra red grilling: provides high heat, usually ceramic, heats until it glows red. Temperatures from 900°F- 1,600°F are not uncommon.
- Smart grills: communicate with your smart phone to let you know when the grill is hot.
- Shish kebab wheel: attaches to your rotisserie spit, holds skewers in place while they cook.
- Charcoal tray: enjoy your gas grill and the flavors associated with charcoal. Fill the tray, place it on the burner and enjoy!
- Colored Porcelain Lids:

Match your lid to your decor













Patio Heaters

- Warm people and surfaces underneath them
- Extend the outdoor season when the temperature starts to drop
- Ignition methods for patio heaters include piezoelectric and automatic electronic starters for easier operation

- Can be viewed as art






